Description								
<p>I teach High School English on a four year cycle. This year we will be spending the first semester learning about poetry, the language of analyzing poetry, the different styles of poetry, and growing in our appreciation for this genre, including writing some poetry of our own. There will be a final test at the end of this semester. The second semester we will be learning how to write a research paper, including how to do in-paper citations, bibliography, and works cited pages. By the end of second semester students will have completed two research papers, one on a topic that is given to them and the other on a topic of their choice.</p> <p>This is a two hour class on Tuesday only.</p>
