Some costumes and props will be borrowed from participating families to be used in the production. There will be a parent meeting the second semester. The director potentially needs 2-3 parents who will oversee set management, props, and other departments. To be able to have a successful performance it will be a team effort that requires some parental involvement, effort & time especially in the 2nd semester.								
Description								
<p>The title of the production is TBA. The script will be chosen from Pioneer Drama. The performance dates will be May 3rd & 4th 2019. We will rehearse, design, construct and produce a play for an audience. Students will gain knowledge in technical theater, confidence in public speaking, and hopefully enjoy camaraderie as they learn to work as a team. All students enrolled in the class will be given acting and technical roles. All students must try out in class in order to get a role in the play at the beginning of the 1st semester. Senior students will have some priority for roles. Students are responsible for making a 2 semester commitment once roles are assigned, as it is extremely difficult to find role replacements and changes can jeopardize the whole production. If the student and parents think there may be any changes in participation status you are strongly advised not to sign up for this class. Roles are assigned by the director and only under special circumstances is parental input expected.</p> <p>The class fee includes: a script, play royalties, a production themed t-shirt, programs for the show and most tech supplies. Communication to the families will be via e-mail, Facebook, the COVE family folders and a parent meeting each semester. Theatre brings fun along with stretching each student. The class time in the second semester will be an hour and a half (until 5:30), with March and April's classes going for two hours each week.</p>								
Homework / Expectations / Other Info								
<p>Student's homework involves memorizing lines, outside of class time character development, character research, and tech role work along with regular tech reports which will be turned in as a portion of the student's grade. Tech team managers carry a bigger load of team management, responsibility and work. ++ Students should have a willingness to be directed, work as a team. ++ Students will be expected to attend all tech days scheduled. One Saturday tech day is anticipated during the 1st semester. During the second semester, there could be 2 or 3 extra tech days which will most likely be scheduled on Saturdays. Tech days will be scheduled and announced at least a month in advance if at all possible. The last two weeks before production there will be 5 to 8 extra practices not just on Tuesdays (times may vary but usually late afternoon or evening for a minimum of 3 hours up to 6 hours each).</p>
