Description								
<p>Students will learn to design pieces and weave on an 18" table loom suitable for producing placemats, bags, and other items. The loom will go home with the student for the semester.</p> <p>In the first few weeks, students will learn to operate the loom and complete a sample project. After that the class will be in a studio format, with students coming to class each week to get help and advice and share work with other students.</p> <p>Those working toward a 1/2 high school credit will have a few specific design assignments for different types of weaving and will need to complete three or more projects over the course of the semester. Others can work completely at their own pace.</p> <p>Some discussion of weaving history in the U.S. and other countries will be included.</p>
