<p>"The heavens are telling of the glory of God; and their expanse is declaring the work of His hands" (Psalm 19:1) Hannah and I love teaching about God's creation and Astronomy has to be one of our favorite subjects. The more and more we learn about the "heavens" the more we are in awe of how marvelous God truly is. In this class your child will be putting together two lapbooks. The first semester we will be concentrating on what "Astronomy" is and what it isn't (it isn't the same as astrology). We will also be looking at the sun, the moon and some planets. The second semester we will finish the planets, learn about space rocks, stars and galaxies, and move on to the wonderful world of space travel. In the last two weeks each student will give a report on a famous astronaut. Our hope for the children taking this class is that they will be able to look at the night sky and see how wonderful and excellent Our Creator truly is.</p>
