Description								
<p>In this class, middle grades students will explore world history of the 1800's through both historical fiction and the literature of those times and places. Titles will be chosen based on students' and parents' needs, but will be appropriate for middle schoolers. I plan to include <i>The Legend of Sleepy Hollow</i>, <i>Lyddie</i>, <i>Across Five Aprils</i>, <i>Tom Sawyer</i>, some short stories, and a little poetry. As you can see, my booklist is far from decided, but we will read about 12 books over the course of the year. All reading will be done at home.</p> <p>In class, we'll discuss, do some small projects related to the time of the book, and learn more about the history of that period.</p> <p>Besides quite a bit of reading, students will complete written assignments on each book. These will primarily be in short essay form, responding to a question or prompt related to the text. Each will receive "IEW-style" feedback on grammar and mechanics, as well as content.</p> <p>This class is not primarily for a grade, but I will be in touch with parents regarding the grade you may wish to assign based on the amount and quality of your student's work. The course does not provide a full year of either English or history, but could be about half of either subject in your homeschool curriculum.</p> <p>This class is the third in a planned series of four years from ancient times to the 20th century.</p>								
Homework / Expectations / Other Info								
<p>Students should have the ability and time to read about 1/2 of a grade-level appropriate novel and write a short essay each week. Please dedicate 4-6 hours of homework time per week to the class.</p>
