Description								
This HS Spanish II course will continue work with grammar, more advanced verb conjugation, and more vocabulary memorization. There will be even more of an emphasis on daily study. Just as with Spanish I students, we will use the KJV of the Spanish Bible to memorize verses and there will be one to three worship songs introduced each month since music is a great memorization tool. It is understood that a student coming into Spanish II will have more of a grasp on verbs and their tenses as well as language structure, numbers and the different placement of them in a sentence according to their usage, (ordinal vs amounts), but we will review these things among some of the necessary vocabulary before diving in. Students need to bring a notebook, pencil, paper, and a Spanish-English dictionary the first day of class. The Spanish Bible is available online and on many phone apps for free, but the purchase of one is not frowned upon if a student prefers to own one.
