Students will need to bring a pencil and spiral notebook to class each week. *For 1st semester performance, students will need black dress pants and black shoes. * For 2nd Semester performance, students will need tan or khacki pants and brown shoes. Description								
<p>The COVE Show Choir is a performance-based class where students will come together as choral team to learn and prepare music of various styles in a fun, engaging and encouraging atmosphere.</p> <p>PLEASE NOTE: While no prior choral experience or audition is necessary to join, it is still beneficial for students to have some ability to hear and match vocal pitch. If you have questions or concerns, feel free to contact the teacher prior to registration. Throughout the year, students will learn safe and proper vocal techniques as they work on Show Choir music, which may include some swing, jazz, pop, Christian and show music with light choreography. Music will be carefully and thoughtfully chosen to be fun, yet appropriate, as representatives of COVE and in regard of Christian values.</p> <p>***Show Choir members will also be offered additional times to gather for social/learning experiences throughout the semester, dates and times TBD.</p> <p>Students will also learn basic music theory to aid in better musicianship. Choir members will gain confidence as they learn performance skills, including stage presence through facial and body expression with text interpretation. Show Choir members are required to perform at one scheduled performance (TBD) each semester, but depending on student interest and availability, a few additional opportunities may arise throughout the year to be considered.</p>								
Homework / Expectations / Other Info								
<p>Students will need to practice and memorize vocal choral parts and light choreography, with set weekly goals at home in preparation of performances.</p> <p>Full and consistent student participaton and attendance in class will be essential to the success of our Show Choir. Attendance at all scheduled performances (one per semester) is a necessary commitment for joining Show Choir. Performance dates are TBD. In additon to learning and preparing choir music, students will occasionally have very light homework in the form of music theory worksheets to be handed in and graded throughout the semester. This will help students to understand the fundamentals of music, which will aid in preparing them with solid musicanship and greatly enhance musical performance.</p>
