Description								
<p>This 8 week class is designed for parents and their adult children that are turning or have turned 18 years old (including COVE graduates) and constantly tell their parents that: "When I am 18, I can do what I want." While the student thinks turning 18 means freedom to do specific things, this class presents the harsh legal reality of adult life. Your teenager wants to move out but do they know anything about leases or suretys, or eviction and money judgments against them? They want their own car but do they know how insurance premiums, points, suspension and revocation work? When they are 18 they are free to be charged and tried as adults in a criminal proceeding, pay for their attorney; and be fined, and sentenced like an adult. They are free to destroy their credit, default on a loan, have their automobile and property be liened, repossessed, garnished and levied. All this and more, now that your 18 . . . .</p>
