

Kristin Dwyer has spent the past twenty-five years working with children in a variety of capacities from youth groups, to classrooms, to homeschooling, to tutoring. She holds a Master's degree in Education as well as two Montessori teacher certifications for Elementary and Secondary. NOTE:

I typically schedule an hour appointment with potential clients to conduct an initial screening. It is not diagnostic in nature (which only a mental health professional can provide) but rather gives me an opportunity to work with the child and consult with the parent to share helpful feedback and determine the appropriateness of tutoring.

I charge \$30 for the screening. Each hour of tutoring is \$45, and I am available for questions via text/email/phone during the intervening periods.
